- 1. Support your children and the team
- 2. Focus on the learning process, how they played, not the outcome.
- 3. Emphasize the positive: *build their self-esteem*.
- 4. Never argue with or complain to the referee. Discuss any issues between halves, with the other coach present.
- 5. Good sportsmanship means being a good winner as well as a gracious loser.
- 6. The goal of the game is to have fun, improve your children's skills and to teach them to be a good team player.
- 7. Only players on my official roster will be allowed to play in games.

By accepting this form I agree that I will adhere to this code of conduct. Fail ure to comply could result in a suspension or other action by the Board. I also will not allow any player to play in a game that is not on my official roster. I understand that if such a player were hurt in a game, I could be personally liable as the club's insurance would not apply to that player.
